## STEP 2: DETERMINE TREATMENT OPTION FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF ALCOHOL WITHDRAWAL SYNDROME (to be completed by the prescriber) RISK OF SEVERE ALCOHOL WITHDRAWAL FIXED DOSE TREATMENT YES **PLUS** Any 2 of the following: SYMPTOM TRIGGERED TREATMENT • Presents with or has had previous withdrawal (standard or reduced dose diazepam or seizures lorazepam) Previous episode of Delirium Tremens • Clinically has alcohol dependence / scoring 15 or above on Alcohol Screening Tool $Audit\,P\breve{C}$ (see step NO 1 in main guideline) SYMPTOM TRIGGERED TREATMENT • High initial symptom score (GMAWS > 8) □ (standard or reduced dose diazepam or (Do not use scoring tool if patient intoxicated or lorazepam) < 8 hours since last drink) **SELECT TREATMENT OPTION:** SYMPTOM TRIGGERED ONLY NO TREATMENT FIXED DOSE PLUS SYMPTOM TRIGGERED Treatment must be prescribed on HEPMA and prescription chart

NOTE! Fixed dose & symptom triggered dosing must be no less than 1 hour apart
