<p>*Notes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ If BM <3.5mmol/l → treat urgently and reassess once blood glucose normal. ▪ If total score > 0 (1 to 5) → diagnosis of acute stroke or TIA is likely. If clinical signs are still present, suspect stroke. ▪ If total scores 0, -1 or -2 → stroke is unlikely but is not excluded and patient should be discussed if appropriate.
